DISTRICT 196 (Rosemount-Apple Valley-Eagan)

District 196 will resume distribution of free grab-and-go meal bags Monday, March 30 while schools are closed because of coronavirus (COVID-19). According to the school closure guidance received from Minnesota Department of Education, all children 18 and under are eligible to receive free meals.

DISTRICT 191 (Burnsville-Eagan-Savage)

DISTRICT 194 (Lakeville)

Starting on Monday, March 30, Lakeville Area Schools will be providing meals to students Monday-Friday. Each meal will include a lunch for that day as well as a breakfast for the next morning. These meals will still be provided during the shelter-in-place order.
