PROFILE OF THE WEEK Mary Wileman, Special Education Teacher & Coordinator

One of the FIT teachers asked a group of 6th graders why they love Ms. Mary Wileman, and they overwhelmingly said, "Because we know that she cares about us!"

Ms. Wileman has been with FIT Academy for 6 years as a Special Education teacher and Coordinator after finishing her education at the University of Wisconsin-Stout. She teaches 6th grade Resource Math and Resource ELA and also teaches 7th-grade Math along with 7th-grade personal skills. "When I am not teaching a class, I walk the hallways, checking in with teachers and students to see if they need my

support. If support is not needed, I assist the SPED department with evaluations, progress monitoring, and coaching."

Ms. Wileman grew up in a family where she was the oldest of 8 children, and some of her siblings have disabilities. She says that **this** is the reason she chose her career path. "I wanted to make a difference and have students feel seen and heard when they think no one else is left to care. I love making students feel welcomed and excited to learn. My students like seeing me dance when I get really excited about their answers and hard work in class."

She says that her "top goal to accomplish with my students each day is that they feel heard. This means that if they have a question, they feel comfortable asking it. If they are having problems at home or with their friends, they know I am someone who will listen to them and help them process it. Even if they are having a hard day, I will be there to pick them up and help make it better."

Outside of school, Ms. Wileman loves playing sports--especially fastpitch softball! She is married and has a dog named Arya. She says, "My favorite place to vacation is my cabin. I love playing in the lake with my siblings."

One of her colleagues says, "she always goes above and beyond for the students. She has organized school-wide field trips, such as last year's Saints game! She is always there to give ideas and support to colleagues to ensure that students are supported and their needs are being met."






MYSTERY READERS!
