
SPRING SEASON INFO

PROFILE OF THE WEEK Kate Johnson, 5th Grade Teacher

Mrs. Kate Johnson received her bachelor's degree from SUNY Oneonta in New York and her master's from Concordia University in St. Paul. She started teaching in Arizona in 2007 before moving to Minnesota. This is her 2nd year teaching 5th grade at FIT Academy. Before FIT, she taught at a charter school in Minneapolis.

Mrs. Johnson says, "I love working with students and helping them get to the 'ah-ha moment' when they finally figure out something that they have been struggling with."

This year, Mrs. Johnson took her class to the Minnesota History Center. After the trip, she talked with the class to see if this was a trip she should do again next year. She says, "Many of my students told me that they want to go again with their families. A few students told me this was the best day for them. And one told me

that they want to go there on their birthday!" She was happy to hear such great feedback about the

field trip!

Outside of school, Mrs. Johnson travels out east each summer to see her family. "We mainly travel to Vermont, New York and Nantucket."
