- has a closing sentence.

How to Writing


For our example this week of How to Writing, we will look at how to make something.


Ways people know how to make meals and snacks:

So this week we are going to write our own directions of how to make something.








Brainstorm - think and plan

Write on the Brainstorming Web paper or make a list of things that you know how to make, create or do REALLY WELL!


For example, I would write:

Tuesday Sequencing Words: First, Next, Then, Finally

- 1. First, watch Brainpopjr: How to Essay https://jr.brainpop.com/readingandwriting/writing/howtoessay/
- 2. Next, you will choose one item from your Brainstorming Web
- 3. Next, think about how to make it and how you will explain the steps to make it to someone else.

(You have to pretend whoever reads your how to has NO IDEA how to do it.

4. Finally, write your steps on the prewriting graphic organizer.

Write 5 sentences: Include your topic sentence.

If you have more than 4 steps, you can add more steps on the back if you need.

Remember to add details - use adjectives to describe everything

Include your conclusion.

Notice we are still sandwich writing.

Wednesday: Write Rough Draft

Today you will write out your essay using the prewriting graphic organizer steps you wrote yesterday.

Make sure you copy/write all 5 sentences on your paper and include the introduction and conclusion including the words already written on the sheet.

EXAMPLE Rough Draft

This Is How You Make I!!

Spaghelli and mealballs is a great dinner. Let me tell you how to make it. First, you cook the spaghetti pasta in a pot of very hot water. Next, heat up a jar of pasta sauce in a pol. Then, roll ground meat into balls, and cook them in a pan. Finally, put the pasta, sauce, and meatballs on a plate. That's how to make spaghetti and meatballs.

I hope my mom makes it for dinner tonight!

Thursday: Revise & Edit

Today we want to add or change details to make the essay more clear.

We need to revise the rough draft by making changes by adding more details

like adjectives and adding follow-up sentences.

[XAMPLE Revised Draff #1

Spaghelli and mealballs is a great dinner. It's really easy to cook. Let me tell you how to make it. First, you need to boil a pot of water. Put spaghetti pasta in the water, and cook it until it's soft. Next, open up a jar of pasta sauce. Pour the sauce into a pot, and heat it up. Editing

Capitalization

- ✓ Beginning of sentence:
- ✓ Names:
- √The word I:

It's time for a snack.

Let's eat with Sam.

I love snack time!

Punctuation

- √ End of sentence: .!? Look at that pizza.
- ✓ Commas when listing:

 It is huge! Do you want to eat now? Let's invite Susan, Juan, and Quentin to share our pizza.

Grammar

✓ Sentences make sense: The boy are is eating a purple popsicle.

Spelling

✓ Words are spelled correctly: The gril girl is drinking lemonade

Edit your paper using checklist

Editing Checklist	
I read my writing out loud to check for errors.	
I capitalized the beginning of my sentences.	
I capitalized names of people, places, and things.	
I capitalized the word "I".	
I used correct punctuation at the end of sentences.	
I used commas when listing things.	
My sentences make sense.	
I checked the spelling of words that didn't look correct.
