

A group of words that tells a complete thought is a sentence. There are four **different kinds of sentences**.

Grammar Rules Kinds of Sentences

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A statement tells something. It ends with a <u>period</u>.	It is morning. The day is just beginning.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A question asks something. It ends with a <u>question mark</u>.	Where did the moon and stars go?
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• An exclamation shows strong feeling. It ends with an <u>exclamation mark</u>.	What a great day! 
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A command tells someone to do something. It ends with a <u>period</u>.	Make your bed, please.


