

## **ACT Testing April 23-26, 2024**

### **2024 MCA and MTAS State Assessments**

Provider: Pearson

Requiring Authority: State of Minnesota

Content Areas Tested: Reading, Math, and Science

Testing Dates: Reading MCA and MTAS (Grades 3-8 & 10) April 8-19, 2024

Math MCA and MTAS (Grades 3-8, & 11) April 8-19, 2024

Science MCA and MTAS (Grades 5, 8, & 10) April 22-30, 2024

MTAS Alternate Tests, May 8-19, 2024

Estimated Duration: Reading: 2.5 to 3 hours. Math: 1.5 to 2.5 hours. Science: 1.5 to 2 hours.

Note that these are estimates as students are not limited in how long they take to complete a test.

Reporting of Results: Individual Student Reports (ISR's) are generated and printed by the state and sent to schools in the Fall. FIT Academy will review the ISR's with parents at parent-teacher conferences or mail them to parents. Parents may request to have them mailed at an earlier date.

State Requirement: FIT Academy is required to administer the MCA state assessments. We are also required by law to post the following document: Parent Guide and Refusal for Student Participation in Statewide Testing

### **Diagnostic Assessments**

Provider: Fastbridge

Requiring Authority: This is a school requirement

Content Areas Tested: Two separate tests, one for reading and one for math

Who Will Be Tested: All students in grades K-10

Testing Dates: September, 2023, January, 2024, & May 2024

Estimated Duration: 45 minutes to 90 minutes per content area. Note that these are estimates as students are not limited in how long they take to complete a test.

Reporting of Results: Results will be reported to parents at the 1st quarter conferences in November as well as at the end of school year when report cards are mailed home.

### **ACCESS Testing for English Language Learners**

Provider: WIDA Requiring Authority: Federal Government

Content Areas Tested: Reading, Writing, Listening, Speaking

Who Will Be Tested: Students who qualified based on pre-screening and received parent permission

Testing Dates: Monday, February 12th: Grade K-8 Listening, Grade 1 Reading Tuesday, March 13th: Grade K-1 Grade Speaking, Grade 2-8 Reading Wednesday, March 14: Grade 1-2 Writing, Grade 3-8 Speaking Thursday, March 15: Grade K-2, 5-8 Writing Friday, March 16: Grade 3-4 Writing, Make-ups

Estimated Duration: Total of 3 hours Reporting of Results: Individual Student Reports (ISR's)
