VISIT TO THE CAPITOL

On Wednesday, March 13th, FIT Superintendent Allaire and parents Kim Bauer and Christine Hubel attended *Charter School Day* at the State Capitol.

This was an opportunity to meet with our legislators and advocate for charter schools. Charter schools are underfunded and don't always have the same resources as traditional schools so meeting with legislators to educate them about the needs of our school is crucial!

We met privately with State Representatives Jeff Witte, Mary Frances Clardy and Robert Bierman as well as Senators Robin Maye-Quade and Zach Duckworth. All were very receptive and benefited from the background we provided about charter schools and FIT Academy specifically. We invited all of them to visit the school and hope to see them here in coming weeks!

We encourage ALL parents to help us educate people about charter schools and particularly your local and state officials. We found the following talking points to be the most important: *In Minnesota, charter schools are much more similar than different from traditional schools. We have to follow all of the same laws and rules in providing a free public education to all. Where we differ is in our mission and the fact that we are a small school community with our own independent school board.*

CALL FOR BOARD NOMINATIONS

On Wednesday, May 15, we will elect members to our FIT Academy Governing Board, and we need your nominations! This Board governs and oversees the school.

Minnesota law requires that charter school boards include at least 5 members who are not related. Members must include at least one of the school's licensed teachers; a parent or legal guardian of a student enrolled at the school; and an interested community member. In addition, members cannot have conflicting interests with the school.

Our school board is currently 7 members strong. For this election, the ideal board composition to be seated is no less than 5, and no more than 7. There can be no group majority on a school board.

We will have the following vacancies this election:

- 1 Parent Seat
- 1 Teacher Seat
- 1 Community Seat
- 1 Other (the next highest vote recipient from any of the three groups)

New board members will begin their terms in June 2024.
