### PROFILE OF THE WEEK Keelin Hurley, Special Education Teacher

Ms. Keelin Hurley joined the FIT Academy faculty in the fall of 2018, and she currently teaches secondary language arts special education. But her roots have not always been planted in Minnesota!

She grew up in Melbourne, Florida, along Florida's Space Coast so, she says, "I am a misplaced beach bum who misses all the launches I could see from my home." She graduated from Florida State with a Bachelor's in Political Science as well as a Master's in Secondary Social Science Education. As a result, she is a huge college football fan, and she loves her Florida State Seminoles!

After teaching for several years, she received a scholarship to attend Mitchell-Hamline School of Law. After graduating from law school, she worked as a staff attorney for the judicial branch and then worked in private practice in criminal and family law. Ms. Hurley says, "I also served on the Minnesota Children's Justice Initiative Board and created systems in which children engaged in the justice system are properly protected and, if necessary, rehabilitated."

In 2015, she returned to the classroom in order to have a more flexible schedule for her family, especially her two children. She says, "My role as a special education teacher is to support students where they are--academically and socially--and to give them instruction that will help them get to grade level." She loves to challenge her students with novels they read in class. The phrase "I can't do this" is not to be spoken in her class! She says, "Over the years, I have watched my students grow and learn that reading can be fun and that it is the fundamental key to success across the board in school."

She is ridiculously proud of her two children. Her son is finishing his freshman year at Saint John's University, and her daughter will graduate from Eagan High School this June. She describes herself as an "exercise nut!" "I do lots of yoga and kickboxing--both are excellent for physical and mental health." In addition to exercise, she loves playing piano, violin, and guitar.
